Del Rosa ES



Group C: Cajon, Pacific, San Bernardino High Schools

- Functional commissioning is underway and is the last phase prior to completion.

Overcrowding Relief Grant (ORG) Projects

Lincoln ES ORG and SDC

- 85% Complete
- Building construction is now complete.

Muscoy ES ORG and SDC

- 25% Complete
- Three (3) existing portable classrooms were removed from the site to allow for the new, two-story building.

Dominguez Elementary Building Ceremony

A Building Ceremony was held for Dominguez Elementary School on March 29, 2013. Members of the Board of Education, City Officials, District Staff and family members of the late H. Frank Dominguez gathered together to celebrate the construction of this new elementary school named after the founder of Vanir Group of Companies. At the age of 25, Mr. Dominguez founded Vanir in the city of San Bernardino. The Vanir Foundation was established in memory of Mr. Dominguez and is dedicated to partnering with schools in underserved communities by meeting basic needs and promoting achievement in science, technology, engineering and math. The celebration was held in the future library and was attended by over 100 guests. The Fort Irwin U.S. Army Color Guard Presented the Colors and Mr. Dominguez's daughter, Dorene C. Dominguez spoke on behalf of Vanir.

H. Frank Dominguez Elementary School will house approximately 600 students in 19 classrooms and will include amenities such as a lunch shelter, computer lab, library and baseball fields. Construction began in August of 2012 and is anticipated to be complete in the fourth quarter of 2013.



Middle College Ribbon Cutting Ceremony


Middle College High School originally opened in 2001 with students attending classes in portable classrooms that were located on the campus of San Bernardino Valley College. In August of 2011 construction began on a permanent campus for Middle College High School. Construction is now complete and a ribbon cutting ceremony was held on March 25, 2013 marking the opening of this new campus.

The ceremony was attended by City of San Bernardino Officials, District Administrators and Staff, members of the Board of Education, community members as well as current and past students. Middle College High School provides students the opportunity to attend both high school and college classes simultaneously. Students have the opportunity to graduate with a high school diploma as well as an Associate's Degree.

Both staff and students are excited to occupy and utilize their new facilities. The new Middle College campus is located across the street from the San Bernardino Valley College Campus at 1260 W. Esperanza St.


