Bradley and Marshall Elementary School Canopy Replacements

- 100% Complete
- Punch list items are all that remain prior to filing Notices of Completion.

Community Day School

- 100% Complete
- Construction is complete and the classrooms are now occupied.

Indian Springs High School Athletic Complex

- 3% Complete
- Construction began in February 2015 with the demolition of existing sitework.

Pacific High School ADA Upgrades

- 98% Complete
- Construction began in December of 2014.
- American Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades to sidewalks, walkways and the campus entrance are now complete.
- ADA accessible parking stalls have been added to the existing West parking lot.





Security Replacement/Upgrades

- 10% Complete
- Construction contract was awarded on February 17, 2015 and construction began over Spring Break.

SMART Building Upgrades

- 35% Complete

- Removal of existing equipment is now complete and the new chiller, coils, air handler and boiler have been delivered.

Multiple ADA Upgrades at Various Elementary Schools

 Construction bids were opened in January 2015 and contracts have been awarded for miscellaneous ADA related work including but not limited to concrete ramps, railing, Path of Travel corrections, concrete, asphalt, parking stalls, signage and fence work including gates. Construction will take place at Barton, Cypress, Emmerton, Highland Pacific, Lankershim, Mt. Vernon, Ramona Alessandro, Rio Vista and Roosevelt Elementary Schools.

Multi-Purpose Building and CID Annex Remodel at the Community Day School

 Notice Inviting Bids are scheduled to advertise in April for the structural modifications; accessibility upgrades; replacement of finishes, roofing, doors and windows; installation of heating, ventilation and air conditioning and fire sprinkler systems; electrical and plumbing upgrades; sitework; landscape and irrigation.

• Development of plans is ongoing.




