Tom discussed the need for a new District Police Department building, there are 32 officers and 70 CSOs and they have no locker or weapon storage and the need to provide facilities that are needed by them. Tom informed the COC that Nicole Miller and Associates assessed 40 campuses for security and safety. They are working on reports for review to incorporate recommendations. They want to have a plan in place by the end of the year. Tom discussed that since the schools have received security cameras, the graffiti at the sites has diminished, which leaves time to get schools painted by M & O.
