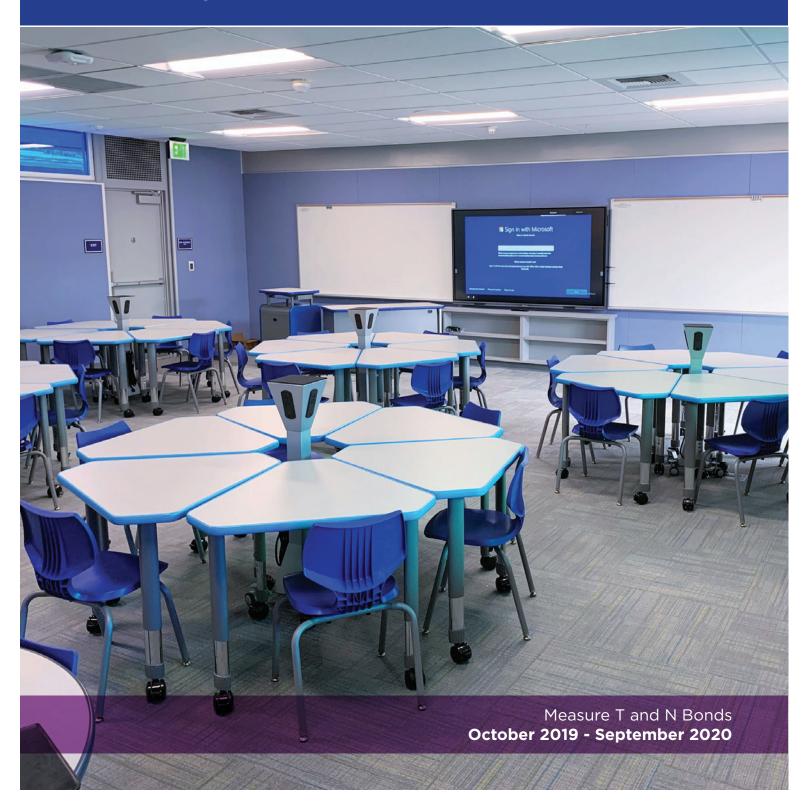
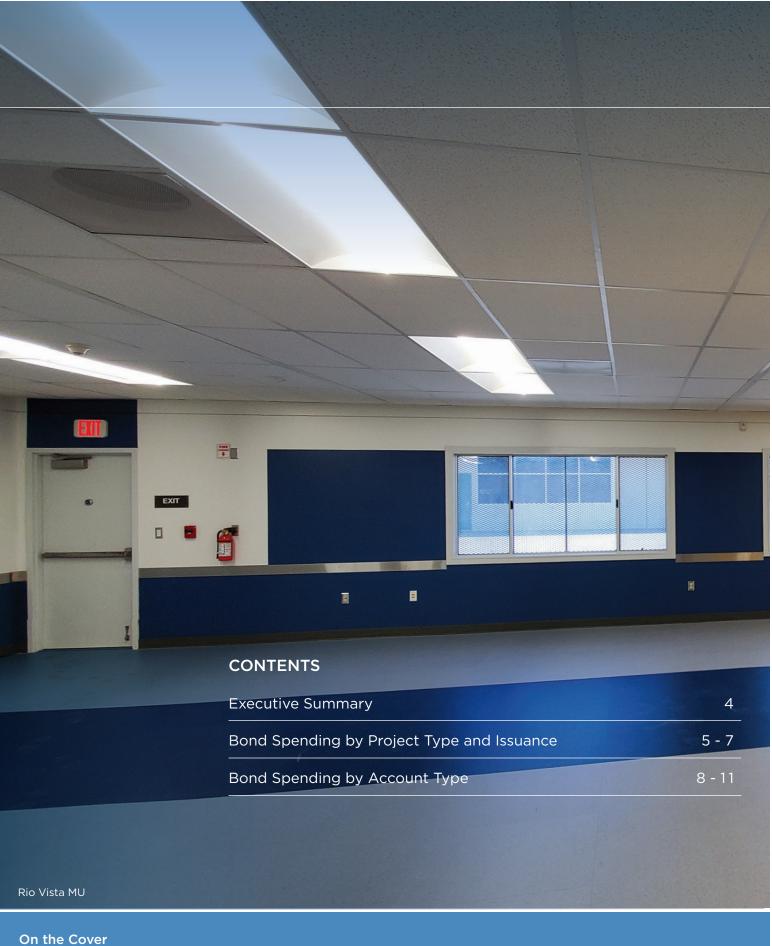

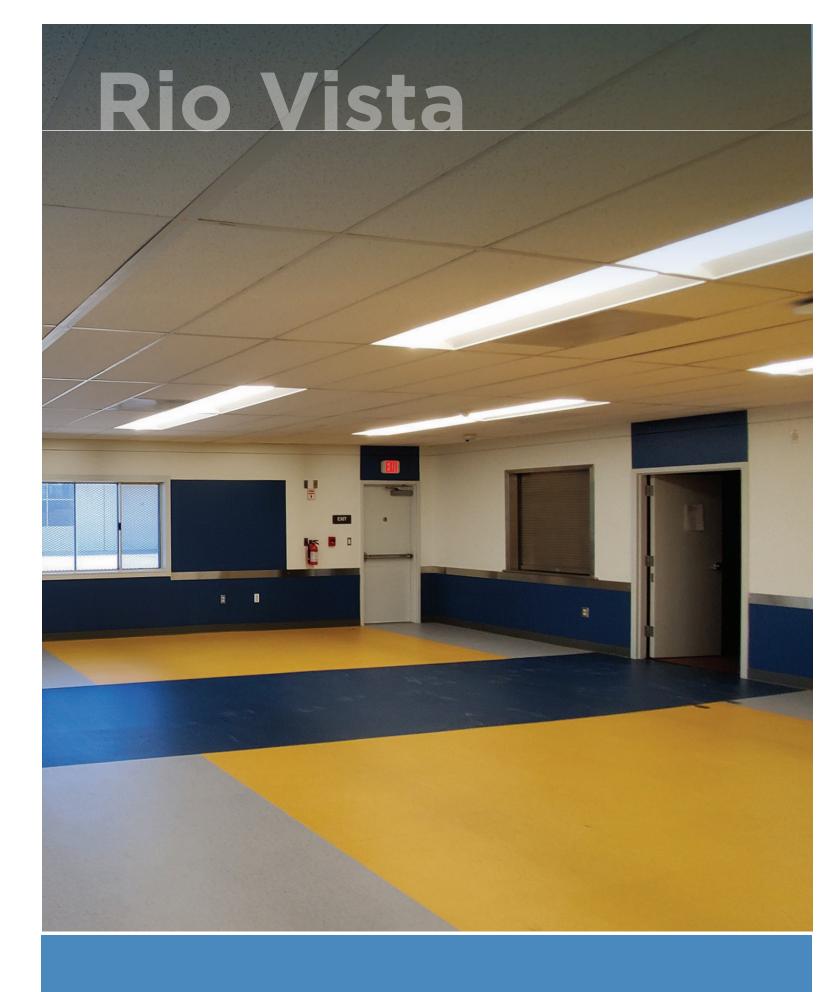

### Bond Spending by Project Type and Issuance

There are several types of projects that have been identified within the Facilities Program. They are briefly defined as follows:

New-New Campuses, SDC-Special Day Classroom Buildings, Mod-Modernization of existing campus, KIT-Kitchen upgrades, ADD-Addition of New Building to existing campus, GP-Growth Portables added to existing campus, and MU-Multi-Use Room upgrades. The last category used is OTHER which encompasses a wide variety of projects such as, but not limited to, Single Point Entry Modifications, Playgrounds, Athletic Complex Improvements and HVAC upgrades.

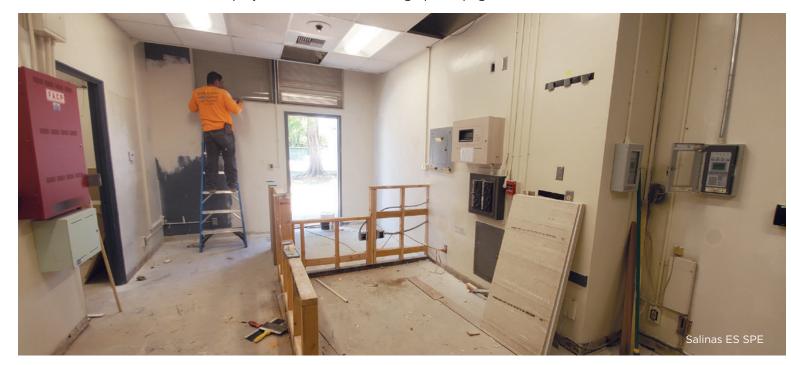
